“Dive Against Debris” Dive Cleanup – Saturday, June 21, 2014 Spanish Rocks Reef, Holmes Beach, Bradenton

Volunteers needed for this event include:

- **Divers** - All divers must be Open Water certified with at least 15 open water dives in their logbook. On the day of the dive cleanup, dive volunteers must submit their signed liability form (will be sent separately with Dive Plan). Diver/surface marker buoys are required for this dive event.
- **Kayaks/canoes** – Volunteers with kayaks or paddleboards will support the divers in the water.
- **Safety observers** – Need pier and shore safety observers. Shore safety observers will assist divers in and out of the water and monitor for boat traffic.
- **Data collectors** - Document debris collected for submission to Ocean Conservancy's Marine Debris Index.

Saturday, June 21, 2014 from 8am-12pm – Spanish Rocks Reef

The Safety Brief will be at 8:30am and divers in the water by 9am

Dive brief and setup will be on the beach at the 33rd street beach access.
