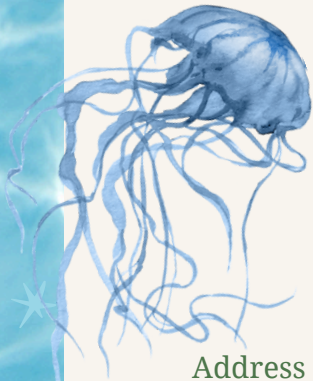


APRIL IS WATER CONSERVATION MONTH

Why save water? Because it's our most precious natural resource, and because at least two-thirds of the U.S. have experienced or are bracing for local, regional, or statewide water shortages!

SAVE OUTDOORS

Be mindful of your water usage, especially when irrigating. Use a hose nozzle to prevent water waste, and use rain sensors to prevent unnecessary watering during or after rain.



Follow your neighborhood's water restrictions for irrigation.

If a drought is declared in our area, go the extra mile to save water.



SAVE INDOORS

Address any leaks in your home promptly to prevent water waste.

Take shorter showers to save water.

Turn off the tap while brushing your teeth or shaving, and only turn it back on to rinse
